TRAIL DESCRIPTIONS:

The historic "Battle Road" walk travels part of the route Paul Revere and Samuel Prescott rode to warn the Colonists that "The Regulars are coming! The Regulars are coming!" Along this same route the colonial Minute Men chased the British back to Boston. Walkers pass the site of Paul Revere's brief capture, historic homes, and Hartwell Tavern with furnishings typical of the Revolutionary era. All this is set in the beautiful fields and woods of the National Park.

RATING:

Both the 10km and 6km walk routes are on a crushed stone dust surface, and have an AVA rating of 1B, suitable for strollers **but not wheelchairs**.

This is an IVV Credit Only event.

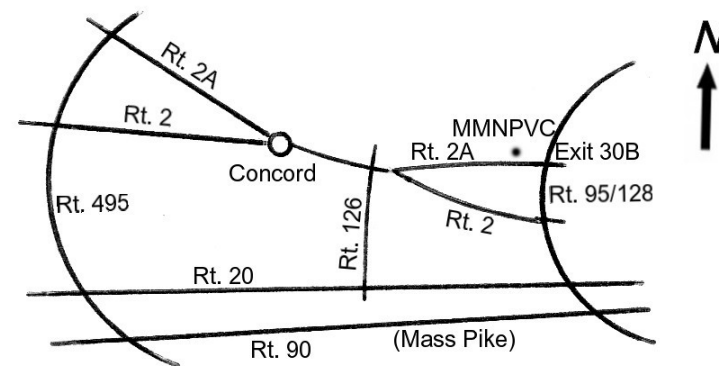
DIRECTIONS:

From Route 95/128:

1. Take Exit 30 B-Route 2A West (Hanscom Field/Concord) for $\frac{2}{3}$ of a mile to the Minute Man National Historical Park.
2. Follow the brown signs to the Visitor Center parking lot located on the right.

From Route 495:

1. Take Exit 29A toward Boston and merge onto Route 2 East.
2. Follow signs to Rt. 2A East/Concord Turnpike.
3. After going under overpass, turn **RIGHT** to stay on Rt. 2A East/Concord Turnpike.
4. Continue on Rt. 2A for 1 mile to Visitor Center parking lot (brown sign) on left.
